

### Arrival

**By car:** take the A2 from Dortmund to Hanover and exit at 'Bielefeld-Zentrum'. Follow the street signs towards the centre ('Zentrum') and then follow the signs to 'Werther'. The ZiF is on the left-hand side of Wertherstrasse, on the slope of the hill. The entrance is signposted.

**By train:** Bielefeld can be reached from any major town by trains running on an hourly schedule (Eurocity train system: marked EC, IC or ICE on the train timetable). From Bielefeld's main station, you can either take a taxior Uber to the ZiF (approx. €10-20) or take tram line 4 (destination "Universität" or "Lohmannshof"). From the "Universität" tram stop, you can reach the ZiF by walking up the hill behind the university's main building (the route is signposted).
